### Project Summary:

The etica group was selected by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources to design a new Visitors Center for the Limberlost State Historic Site located in Geneva, Indiana. The Limberlost Historic Site is the home of Gene Stratton-Porter who is one of Indiana's most famous female authors. The Visitor Center Project was initiated by the DNR to complement the site by providing administrative offices, an exhibit space to view historic artifacts, classroom learning spaces for students, and access to the nature and bird viewing areas. The Visitors Center project consists of the complete design of a one-story, slab on grade 3800 s.f. building. The design was sympathetic to the existing home and carriage house on the adjacent site.
